

Georgia / South Carolina Chapter report for 2017

The Ga/SC chapter of FFLA currently has 16 members, which is up 4 members from a year or so ago. I am planning to soon register 5 Eastern Georgia fire towers that were visited a year ago at the Southeastern Board meeting, having information and photos in hand for each.
